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What you should know about

Duraflor[®] Halo
5% Sodium Fluoride White Varnish

Your dental professional has just applied Duraflor[®] Halo Fluoride Varnish to your teeth. In case you have some questions, please review the following information below.

What is tooth sensitivity?

Tooth sensitivity is caused by gums receding that expose small microscopic holes called dental tubules. Dental tubules are filled with liquid and lead directly to the nerve center of the tooth. This can cause discomfort and sensitivity to hot and cold liquids.

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How is Duraflor[®] Halo applied?

Duraflor[®] Halo provides relief to sensitive teeth by coating the dental tubules. It is applied by brushing on a very thin coat of varnish to the affected areas. Duraflor[®] Halo sets on contact with saliva or moisture and will dry within 10 seconds. You may leave immediately after the treatment. When dry, any excess varnish may appear "spotty" and may slide off the tooth surface. This will not affect the efficacy of the product as there is still a full layer of varnish on the tooth.

What is the recommended time to leave Duraflor[®] Halo on your teeth?

For best results, Duraflor[®] Halo fluoride varnish should remain on your teeth for approximately 4-6 hours for the maximum effect. After the treatment, it is recommended that you only eat soft foods and drink cold liquids for two hours after treatment. The varnish can be removed by brushing and flossing after the recommended time.
